Has your neighbourhood held an activity with a special focus? Then your neighbourhood might qualify for a special award. Be sure to highlight how your neighbourhood activity was organized around a certain community value when you register with the Festival of Neighbourhoods to qualify for one of the special awards listed:

Neighbourhood Connections Award Demonstrating a need and desire to improve the neighbourhood and the quality of life of its residents **Inclusion Award** Purposefully designing a neighbourhood gathering to be inclusive of diversity

Arts & Culture Award Using arts and culture as a means of bringing neighbours together

Green Neighbourhood Award Gathering neighbours for environmental action, conservation or beautification

Safer Neighbourhood Award Building a stronger, safer neighbourhood by encouraging community engagement and participation

Youth Award Celebrating youth leadership in bringing their neighbours together

Heritage Award Recognizing the heritage of our neighbourhood and community in our neighbourhood gathering

Newcomer Award First time registrant with Festival of Neighbourhoods **Pillar Award** Neighbourhood participation for five or more years

Schneider Creek Porch Party brought neighbours together around music, making it eligible for the Arts & Culture Award




Mount Hope-Breithaupt reflected on its transformation from manufacturing to hi-tech industries on Jane's Walk, making it eligible for the Heritage Award
