Reach Out to New Neighbours at Your Next Get-Together

Feeling welcome when you are the new kid in the block is awesome

Neighbourhood gatherings are a great chance to meet neighbours face to face. We all know how sometimes this is difficult, even after living in the same place for many years. For new-comers, being invited to a neighbourhood gathering soon after arrival is a golden opportunity to meet their neighbours, start feeling like they belong in their neighbourhood, and to build a social network close to home.

Don't forget to reach out to new neighbours when you organize your next neighbourhood gathering. Make sure they know they are invited. Hand deliver an invitation and talk to them about what is being organized. They might not know the location, or the activity, or even understand why neighbours would be getting together!

The *Reach! Challenge* outlines ways to make sure no one in your neighbourhood is left out. You will find tips that will help you target barriers to inclusion that might apply to your neighbourhood. Check it out if you are not sure how to make everyone feel welcome at your next neighbourhood gathering.


